Your child is now due the Teenage Booster vaccinations. These are vaccinations to protect against Tetanus, Diphtheria, Polio (Td/IPV) and Meningitis ACWY (Men ACWY).

The vaccination session in your child's school is on **28 March.** The consent form must be completed by **25 March** for your child to have the vaccine at the school session. Frequently Asked questions

Q: How do I know if my child is due these vaccinations?

A: Check your NHS app or contact your GP surgery.

Q: What treatments would affect my child's immune system?

A: This would be treatment such as chemotherapy or on antiviral treatment.

Q: How do I know if my child has a bleeding disorder?

A: A confirmed diagnoses from GP/hospital doctor of a condition where the blood does not clot quickly (not including nosebleeds).

Q: What are the ingredients in the vaccine?
