**Re: Industrial Action by the National Education Union (NEU) - Thursday, 02 March 2023**

As a result of strike action being taken by the NEU, the school has taken the difficult decision to restrict pupil attendance on Thursday, 02 March - the school will be open to Year 11 pupils only.

Year 11 Pupils

Year 11 pupils should attend school at 9.00am and proceed directly to the main hall where they will be registered and advised of the Year 11 lessons that are running. Where lessons / staff are not available, pupils will be required to undertake supervised study / independent revision. School will finish at 2.45pm.

Years 7, 8, 9, & 10

School is not open to these year groups and so pupils will need to remain at home. Pupils are advised to check and complete any work set for them via their Google Classroom account and engage with the resources / links signposted on the Remote Learning section of the school's website:
