Dear Parent/Carer of a Year 11 pupil

Now that the Year 11 Mocks have finished, I am writing to outline how results will be shared with pupils and parents:

- Pupils and parents will now receive the second set of Year 11 reports on the morning of Thursday, 7 December in time for the Year 11 Parents Evening on the same date.
- Pupils will also receive their mock result envelopes from their tutors on Thursday, 7 December from 8.30 in the TCC. They will then have an assembly that relates specifically to the successes and areas for development arising from the mock results.

Hopefully, as in past years, Year 11 pupils learn valuable lessons from sitting their mocks and opening their envelopes. The key lesson that we will emphasise is that there is still time, between now and May, for pupils to make a positive impact on their potential final grades. Pupils who work steadily, listen carefully in lessons and attend any extra offer of provision (lesson 6/holiday workshops) will only enhance their progress.

As with the Year 10 summer mock exams, the pupils treated the mock period seriously in terms of the exam hall protocols which is very gratifying to note. There will be another two-week period of mocks at the end of February 2024. This serves two purposes - to enable pupils and parents to gauge current progress levels ahead of the final exams and to further acclimatise pupils as to how to approach their 'real' exams. This will, again, be followed by Year 11 reports and a Year 11 Parents' Evening at the end of March 2024.

I hope that pupils and parents find the mock process both useful and instructive.
