## Re: Springfield Sixth Form Week, 14-18 June 2021

We are very much looking forward to our Year 11 students' last week of term and being able to offer them what we hope will be an engaging and different experience prior to their leaving school.

Students should study this prospectus carefully and ensure that they <u>sign up to their preferred</u> <u>sessions no later than 3pm on Monday 24 May</u>. To sign up, students should complete the on-line sign up form, accessible via:

## Please note that to access the form, you must first be logged into your school Gmail account.

A few points that students must note before they complete the on-line form:

- We hope that students will sign up for as many classes as possible. When signing up for classes, they should note that they are required to do so in morning and afternoon 'blocks' that run from 9am to 11am; and from 11.30 am to 13:30 am. If attending in the morning or afternoon (or both), the expectation is that they remain on site for that whole time.
- The sign up form notes the 'masterclasses' and other key activities that are on offer. If courses are oversubscribed, students will be automatically allocated an alternative class. In addition to the classes listed in the prospectus and on the on-line form, subject seminars will be available.
- Students should not opt for the same class more than once on the on-line form. For example, if they would like to attend 'Criminology', they should only select it once on one day, and not on both occasions that it is listed.
- It is not an expectation that students attend every morning and afternoon; we want them to
  experience a degree of choice and a sense of the sixth form experience. However, positive
  engagement and substantial attendance (≥ 50%) is required for students to take part and
  also for them to be able to attend the leavers' event which commences at 2.30pm after the
  final classes conclude on 18 June.

Year 11 students do not have to wear uniform during Springfield's Sixth Form week. However, non-uniform should be reasonably smart and appropriate for school; shorts, vest-tops, garments with slogans and similar are not acceptable.
