Human Papillomavirus Vaccination (HPV)

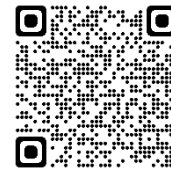
Your child is now able to have the HPV vaccination, this is offered to all young people aged 12 – 13 years. The HPV vaccination is now a one dose programme.

HPV has been linked to some types of cancer, including cervical, head and neck cancers. It can also cause genital warts. Having the HPV vaccination is one of the best ways to protect against the HPV virus.

Frequently Asked Questions

Q: Could my child have received any doses of the HPV vaccine elsewhere?

A: Occasionally the GP may give this vaccination or they may have had it at a previous school.

Q: What treatments would affect my child's immune system?

A: This would be treatment such as chemotherapy or on antiviral treatment.

Q: What are the ingredients in the vaccine?

A: We use the Gardasil 9 Vaccine and a list of the ingredients can be found in the patient information leaflet here <https://bit.ly/480yh8k>

Q: What are the side effects from the HPV vaccine?

A: There are some common side effects such as pain, swelling and redness where the jab is given but these often do not last long. For the full list of side effects and how common they are please see the information leaflet from the vaccine <https://bit.ly/480yh8k>

Q: My child has additional needs, how can you support them?

A: We often work with children who have additional needs and are happy to offer more support, time and encouragement for them.

Q: My child has missed the school session, how can they be vaccinated?

A: If you have completed the online form you will receive an email from Inhealthcare to book into a community clinic.

If you have not completed the online form, please complete this and you will be able to book into a community clinic.
