

## 2018 GCSE RESULTS

### THE HEADLINES:

- 71% of the cohort attained a standard Pass (grade 4+) in both English and Mathematics
- 50% of the cohort attained a strong Pass (Grade 5+) in both English and Mathematics
- 65% of the cohort attained 5+ standard passes including English and Maths
- 65% of the cohort are entered for the English Baccalaureate (Grade 4+ in English & Maths and in 2 Sciences, History or Geography and a Modern Foreign Language)
- EBacc average point score is 4.54\*
- Attainment 8 is 48.3
