#### The people of Ukraine need our help!




- On the 24th February 2022, Russia invaded Ukraine.
- Since then, over 1.5 million people have begun fleeing their homes to seek safety in neighbouring countries; Poland, Moldova, Romania & Hungary.
- The Russian military have been shelling towns and cities across Ukraine, causing a humanitarian crisis.

Springfield School intends to raise money for the humanitarian crisis...



The British Red Cross is a member of the Disasters Emergency Committee (DEC), which brings together 14 leading UK aid agencies to raise money at times of humanitarian crisis. By working together, the charities can raise more money to reach those in need at crisis point.

Springfield School is going to fundraise and donate all proceeds to the British Red Cross.



## How will the British Red Cross use donations to help those in need in Ukraine?

#### The British Red Cross will be...

- Supporting families with buying food, first aid and medicines
- Supporting hospitals and healthcare facilities
- Repairing vital infrastructure

Helping to repair homes, healthcare centres, schools and community

centres.



#### Why is the British Red Cross only accepting cash donations for Ukraine and not items?

- Cash donations are by far the quickest, safest, and most direct way to help people and to support the work of the Red Cross in Ukraine and neighbouring countries.
- A cash donation means the British Red Cross can help with whatever is needed, source things locally, and transport items quickly. It also means volunteers can concentrate on the response, rather than sorting and transporting donations.

Please note: There are other charitable organisations locally collecting items including health & sanitary products, toys, clothing, bottled water and more.

#### What can the money we raise provide?

### Our fundraising could go a long way to help people who need it right now in Ukraine and bordering countries:

- £10 could provide a hygiene kit to a family of five, giving them supplies to stay healthy for a month.
- £20 could provide five blankets to families taking shelter.
- £33 could provide 40 chlorine tablets to ensure that families have access to clean, safe water.
- £72 could provide a thermometer to help treat those who have fallen ill.
- £210 could provide a fully equipped first aid kit, including supplies, to a first aider treating those wounded.
