

Excellent Outcomes



GCSE 2023

- Our top performing student in 2023 achieved 11 GCSEs, including 7 seven Grade 9s and one Grade 8!
- 73% of the cohort attained Grade 4+ (standard pass) in English
- 63% of the cohort attained Grade 4+ (standard pass) in Maths
- 58% of the cohort entered the English Baccalaureate
- 62% of the cohort attained 5+ GCSEs at Grade 4+
