# Changing landscape of education

- As parents will be aware by now, the Government introduced a new grading system for GCSE results, starting with Maths and English, in 2017 and now affecting <u>all</u> subjects
- The numbers will approximately equate as follows:



### 'That still confuses me'



Notable successes\*\*:

- 64% of the year group attained a grade 4+ in both English and Mathematics
- 65% of the year group attained a 4+ in Double Science
- 59% of pupils achieved a grade 5 in both English and Maths (compared to all schools in Portsmouth – 48% - 2021)
- 109 grades at grade 9 increasing with current appeals (Top 4.5% of the country)

# The structure of GCSE

- Very much like the old 'O' Level structure (pre 1987!)
- 'Linear' Year 10 and Year 11 pupils study for two years and then complete exams in that subject at the end of the two years
- A very limited number of subjects keep some Controlled Assessments (practical subjects) which are a small % of the final grade – Art, Food, Media Studies
- The majority of subjects are assessed completely through the end examinations

# English

- Pupils have 4 exams at the end of Year 11, two Language and two Literature exams
- •There will be assessments every term in Year 10 as a way of preparing for the terminal exams
- •The Literature exam is assessed on:

a Shakespeare text

a 19<sup>th</sup> century text

a Modern text

a poetry Anthology

•None of the texts can be taken in to the exam – pupils have to commit a lot to memory

•Head of English recommends pupils buy their chosen book in Year 10 and reads them at least twice (own copies mean annotations)

### Maths

- The expectation of what KS4 pupils can do has been raised A/S Level Maths topics have been brought into KS4
- There are 3 exams at the end of Year 11, two calculator and one non calculator exams (scientific calculator required)
- There are termly assessments during Year 10 pupils need to revise well to ease pressures next year
- Exact tiers of entry will be finalised in Y11 (Foundation/Higher)

### Science

•A series of 'required practicals' over the course of the two years that should be referred to in the exams

•10 for Biology, 8 for Chemistry, 8 for Physics

•21 for Combined Science

•6 exams at the end of Year 11in the 3 subjects

•A much greater emphasis on Maths in the exams

•An expectation that pupils will be able to remember more subject content for examination purposes - revision maps to support

# Implications for Year 10

- Work completed over the course of Year 10 and 11 needs to be careful, easy to revise
- With syllabus content and knowledge being tested 100% by terminal examination in many cases it is vital that pupils are in school and focussed
- Regular, timed, assessments in class will become the norm pupils need to use them as 'self trackers'
- Extremely difficult to 'wing it' if a pupil has not worked over the two years, it will show...
- Conversely, pupils who work hard should be rewarded
